Clients eligible for the Commonwealth Enhanced Primary Care Program (CEPCP) can claim Medicare rebates for Audiology services. Discuss your eligibility with your GP prior to making an appointment.

Medicare does not fund hearing tests or hearing aids. We recommend that clients check their individual health funds for information on rebates.
